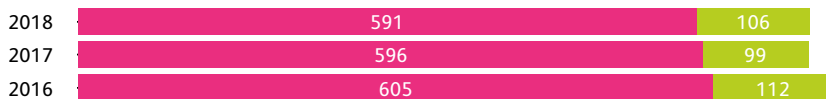

697 bachelor's and master's students

697 students attended 11 bachelor's specialisations and 3 master's degree programmes in Design, Film and Fine Arts. 404 were enrolled in Design, 157 in Film and 136 in Fine Arts courses. The art foundation course has been the basis of our students' education since 1922 and also serves as a pre-admission course for the Design programme. 101 persons attended it in 2018.
